1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to requiring a school district to post on the district's
 1-24 Internet website the contact information of the school
 1-25 administrator primarily responsible for student discipline at a
 1-26 district campus.

1-27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-28 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
 1-29 Section 26.015 to read as follows:

1-30 Sec. 26.015. POSTING OF INFORMATION REGARDING
 1-31 ADMINISTRATOR RESPONSIBLE FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE. A school
 1-32 district shall post on the district's Internet website, for each
 1-33 district campus, the e-mail address and dedicated telephone number
 1-34 of a person clearly identified as:

1-35 (1) the campus behavior coordinator designated under
 1-36 Section 37.0012; or

1-37 (2) if the district has been designated as a district
 1-38 of innovation under Chapter 12A and is exempt from the requirement
 1-39 to designate a campus behavior coordinator under Section 37.0012
 1-40 under the district's local innovation plan, a campus administrator
 1-41 designated as being responsible for student discipline.

1-42 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
 1-43 school year.

1-44 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-45 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-46 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-47 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-48 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
