1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the use of hotel occupancy tax revenue by certain
 1-24 municipalities.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 351.101, Tax Code, is amended by adding
 1-27 Subsection (q) to read as follows:

1-28 (q) In addition to the purposes provided by Subsections (a)
 1-29 and (e), a municipality with a population of more than 10,000 that
 1-30 has a city hall located less than three miles from a space center
 1-31 operated by an agency of the federal government and that is wholly
 1-32 located in a county with a population of four million or more may
 1-33 use revenue from the hotel occupancy tax for the construction,
 1-34 improvement, enlarging, equipping, renovating, repairing,
 1-35 operation, and maintenance of a coliseum or multiuse facility and
 1-36 related infrastructure or a venue, as defined by Section
 1-37 334.001(4), Local Government Code, that is related to the promotion
 1-38 of tourism, including a hotel, resort, or convention center
 1-39 facility located on land owned by the municipality or a nonprofit
 1-40 corporation acting on behalf of the municipality.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
