 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the location of the Alamo Cenotaph.  
 1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 2166, Government Code, is  
 1-26 amended by adding Section 2166.5012 to read as follows:  
 1-27 Sec. 2166.5012. ALAMO CENOTAPH. (a) In this section,  
 1-28 "Alamo Cenotaph" means the memorial to the Alamo defenders located  
 1-29 in the Alamo complex.  
 1-30 (b) Notwithstanding Subchapter I, Chapter 31, Natural  
 1-31 Resources Code, or any other law, the City of San Antonio, or any  
 1-32 other entity, may not move the Alamo Cenotaph from the location  
 1-33 where the cenotaph was first placed following its completion  
 1-34 unless:  
 1-35 (1) the move is approved in a public hearing by at  
 1-36 least two of the following:  
 1-37 (A) the commissioner of the General Land Office;  
 1-38 (B) one member of the Texas Historical Commission  
 1-39 who is designated by the commission to represent the commission;  
 1-40 and  
 1-41 (C) one officer of the Daughters of the Republic  
 1-42 of Texas who is designated by the organization's officers to  
 1-43 represent the organization; and  
 1-44 (2) the cenotaph is moved:  
 1-45 (A) temporarily for repairs; or  
 1-46 (B) permanently to a location within the Alamo  
 1-47 Plaza.  
 1-48 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
