1-23 relating to consolidation of annual reporting requirements of the  
 1-24 Texas Workforce Commission.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 122.022(a), Human Resources Code, is  
 1-27 amended to read as follows:

1-28 (a) ~~The [On or before November 1 of each year, the]~~  
 1-29 workforce commission shall include in the commission's  
 1-30 supplemental annual report to the governor and the legislature  
 1-31 under Section 301.065(c), Labor Code, a ~~[prepare an annual]~~  
 1-32 financial report in the form prescribed by Section 2101.011,  
 1-33 Government Code, relating to the workforce commission's activities  
 1-34 under this chapter ~~[and file the report with the governor and the~~  
 1-35 ~~presiding officer of each house of the legislature].~~

1-36 SECTION 2. Section 301.065, Labor Code, is amended by  
 1-37 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-38 (c) At the time the commission submits the annual report  
 1-39 under this section, the commission shall submit to the governor and  
 1-40 the legislature a separate supplemental annual report consisting of  
 1-41 any information required by other law to be included in the  
 1-42 supplemental annual report.

1-43 SECTION 3. Section 302.0031(g), Labor Code, is amended to  
 1-44 read as follows:

1-45 (g) ~~The [Not later than November 1 of each year, the]~~  
 1-46 commission, after consultation with the Texas Higher Education  
 1-47 Coordinating Board, shall include in the commission's supplemental  
 1-48 annual report to the legislature and the governor under Section  
 1-49 301.065(c) [on]:

1-50 (1) the results of any grants awarded under this  
 1-51 section;

1-52 (2) the best practices for veterans and military  
 1-53 servicemembers to achieve maximum academic or workforce education  
 1-54 credit at institutions of higher education for military experience,  
 1-55 education, and training obtained during military service;

1-56 (3) measures needed to facilitate the award of  
 1-57 academic or workforce education credit by institutions of higher  
 1-58 education for military experience, education, and training  
 1-59 obtained during military service;

1-60 (4) other related measures needed to facilitate the

2-1 entry of trained, qualified veterans and military servicemembers  
2-2 into the workforce;

2-3 (5) the number of academic or workforce education  
2-4 semester credit hours awarded under the program and applied toward  
2-5 a degree or certification program at an institution of higher  
2-6 education during the most recent academic year, disaggregated by  
2-7 the subject area for which the credit hours are awarded; and

2-8 (6) the number of transfer credit hours awarded under  
2-9 the program and applied toward a degree or certification program at  
2-10 an institution of higher education during the most recent academic  
2-11 year.

2-12 SECTION 4. Section 302.007(a), Labor Code, is amended to  
2-13 read as follows:

2-14 (a) The commission shall include in the commission's  
2-15 supplemental [submit an] annual report to the governor and the  
2-16 legislature under Section 301.065(c) a report on the effectiveness  
2-17 of federal programs designed to provide trade adjustment assistance  
2-18 to persons in this state.

2-19 SECTION 5. Section 303.006(c), Labor Code, is amended to  
2-20 read as follows:

2-21 (c) The commission shall include in the commission's  
2-22 supplemental annual [executive director shall] report to the  
2-23 governor and the legislature under Section 301.065(c) a report on  
2-24 [at the end of each fiscal year] the status of the program  
2-25 established under this chapter.

2-26 SECTION 6. Section 305.029, Labor Code, is amended to read  
2-27 as follows:

2-28 Sec. 305.029. ANNUAL REPORT. The commission shall include  
2-29 in the commission's supplemental annual report to the governor and  
2-30 [prepare and deliver to] the legislature under Section 301.065(c) a  
2-31 [an annual] report regarding the grant program established under  
2-32 this chapter. The report shall include for the period covered by  
2-33 the report:

2-34 (1) the number of students who received grants under  
2-35 this chapter; and

2-36 (2) the number of those students who attended each  
2-37 eligible institution, including information on the race or  
2-38 ethnicity of those students attending each institution.

2-39 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
