1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the eligibility of certain events to receive funding  
 1-24 through the Major Events Reimbursement Program.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Sections 5A(a)(4) and (5), Chapter 1507 (S.B.  
 1-27 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article  
 1-28 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as  
 1-29 follows:

1-30 (4) "Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate  
 1-31 Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National  
 1-32 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, the National  
 1-33 Hockey League All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star  
 1-34 Game, a game of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl  
 1-35 Championship Series or its successor or a National Collegiate  
 1-36 Athletic Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision  
 1-37 postseason playoff or championship game, the National Collegiate  
 1-38 Athletic Association men's or women's lacrosse championships, a  
 1-39 World Cup Soccer game, the World Cup soccer tournament, the Major  
 1-40 League Soccer All-Star Game, the Major League Soccer Cup, the  
 1-41 Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association National Finals Rodeo, an  
 1-42 Elite Rodeo Association World Championship, the United States Open  
 1-43 Championship, the World Games, a national collegiate championship  
 1-44 of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the  
 1-45 sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an  
 1-46 Olympic activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training  
 1-47 program, or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic  
 1-48 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, the Amateur  
 1-49 Athletic Union Junior Olympic Games, a mixed martial arts  
 1-50 championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula One  
 1-51 automobile race, the Moto Grand Prix of the United States, the  
 1-52 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) All-Star  
 1-53 Race, the season-ending Championship Race for the National  
 1-54 Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), the Academy of  
 1-55 Country Music Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association Triple  
 1-56 Crown, a championship event in the National Reined Cow Horse  
 1-57 Association (NRCHA) Championship Series, a national political  
 1-58 convention of the Republican National Committee or the Democratic  
 1-59 National Committee, a presidential general election debate, or the  
 1-60 largest event held each year at a sports entertainment venue in this

2-1 state with a permanent seating capacity, including grandstand and  
2-2 premium seating, of not less than 125,000. The term includes any  
2-3 activities related to or associated with an event.

2-4 (5) "Site selection organization" means:

2-5 (A) the National Football League, the National  
2-6 Collegiate Athletic Association, the National Basketball  
2-7 Association, ESPN or an affiliate, the National Hockey League,  
2-8 Major League Baseball, the Federation Internationale de Football  
2-9 Association (FIFA), the International World Games Association, the  
2-10 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), Dorna  
2-11 Sports, the Amateur Athletic Union, the Professional Rodeo Cowboys  
2-12 Association, the Elite Rodeo Association, Major League Soccer, the  
2-13 United States Golf Association, or the United States Olympic  
2-14 Committee;

2-15 (B) the national governing body of a sport that  
2-16 is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, the National  
2-17 Thoroughbred Racing Association, Formula One Management Limited,  
2-18 or the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile;

2-19 (C) the Academy of Country Music;

2-20 (D) the National Cutting Horse Association;

2-21 (E) the National Reined Cow Horse Association  
2-22 (NRCHA);

2-23 (F) the Republican National Committee or the  
2-24 Democratic National Committee;

2-25 (G) [~~(F)~~] the Ultimate Fighting Championship; or

2-26 (H) [~~(G)~~] the Commission on Presidential  
2-27 Debates.

2-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
2-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
2-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
2-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
2-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
