S.B. No. 1443

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the Texas Military Preparedness Commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 436.105(d), Government Code, is amended
5 to read as follows:

6 (d) The task force is abolished and this section expires
7 September 1, 2023 [2021].

8 SECTION 2. Section 436.205(b), Government Code, is amended
9 to read as follows:

10 (b) The panel shall evaluate each grant application and
11 assign the applicant a score based on:

12 (1) the significance of the adverse or positive effect
13 within the local governmental entity[, ~~including the number of jobs~~
14 ~~that may be lost or gained in relation to the workforce in the local~~
15 ~~governmental entity's jurisdiction and the effect on the entity's~~
16 ~~and surrounding area's economy and tax revenue~~]; and

17 (2) any other criteria established by the commission
18 [the extent to which the local governmental entity may have used its
19 existing resources to promote local economic development;

20 [(3) the amount of any grant that the local
21 governmental entity has previously received under this subchapter.]

22 [(4) the anticipated number of jobs that may be
23 created or retained in relation to the amount of the grant sought;

24 and

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1 [~~(5) the extent to which the grant will affect the~~
2 ~~region in which the local governmental entity is located~~].

3 SECTION 3. Section [436.207](#), Government Code, is repealed.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
