1-17 relating to the Texas Military Preparedness Commission.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 436.105(d), Government Code, is amended
 1-20 to read as follows:

1-21 (d) The task force is abolished and this section expires
 1-22 September 1, 2023 [2021].

1-23 SECTION 2. Section 436.205(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-24 to read as follows:

1-25 (b) The panel shall evaluate each grant application and
 1-26 assign the applicant a score based on:

1-27 (1) the significance of the adverse or positive effect
 1-28 within the local governmental entity [~~including the number of jobs~~
 1-29 ~~that may be lost or gained in relation to the workforce in the local~~
 1-30 ~~governmental entity's jurisdiction and the effect on the entity's~~
 1-31 ~~and surrounding area's economy and tax revenue]; and~~

1-32 (2) any other criteria established by the commission
 1-33 [~~the extent to which the local governmental entity may have used its~~
 1-34 ~~existing resources to promote local economic development;~~

1-35 [~~(3) the amount of any grant that the local~~
 1-36 ~~governmental entity has previously received under this subchapter;~~

1-37 [~~(4) the anticipated number of jobs that may be~~
 1-38 ~~created or retained in relation to the amount of the grant sought;~~

1-40 [~~(5) the extent to which the grant will affect the~~

1-42 SECTION 3. Section 436.207, Government Code, is repealed.

1-43 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
