 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to municipal registration of vacant buildings.  
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-19 SECTION 1. Section 214.233(a), Local Government Code, is  
 1-20 amended to read as follows:  
 1-21 (a) A municipality [~~located in a county with a population of~~  
 1-22 ~~two million or more~~] may adopt an ordinance requiring owners of  
 1-23 vacant buildings to register their buildings by filing a  
 1-24 registration form with a designated municipal official.  
 1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
