1-17 relating to the creation of a grant program to assist certain
 1-18 counties with employing or contracting for a qualified emergency
 1-19 management coordinator.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 88, Education Code, is
 1-22 amended by adding Section 88.823 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 88.823. GRANT PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN COUNTIES.

1-24 (a) Using available funds or private donations, the extension
 1-25 service shall establish and administer a grant program to award
 1-26 grants to counties with a population of less than 10,000 to assist a
 1-27 county in employing or contracting with a qualified emergency
 1-28 management coordinator.

1-29 (b) The extension service shall adopt rules to implement and
 1-30 administer the grant program created under this section, including
 1-31 rules regarding applications by and the eligibility of counties
 1-32 described by Subsection (a) for grants under the program.

1-33 (c) The extension service may accept gifts, grants, and
 1-34 donations for the grant program created under this section.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
