Section 2003.025(a), Government Code, is amended 1-30 to read as follows:

1-31 (a) This section applies to a state agency that has entered 1-32 into a contract with the office for the conduct of hearings and 1-33 alternative dispute resolution procedures for the agency, 1-34 including a contract under Section 2003.024 or[, 2003.048,] 1-35 2003.049[, or 2003.105], during any of the three most recent state 1-36 fiscal years.

1-37 SECTION 3. Sections 2003.048 and 2003.105, Government Code, 1-38 are repealed.

1-39 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 1-40 an interagency contract entered into on or after the effective date 1-41 of this Act. An interagency contract entered into before that date 1-42 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective 1-43 date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that 1-44 purpose.
