 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to used and scrap tire handlers.  
 1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety  
 1-26 Code, is amended by adding Section 361.0851 to read as follows:  
 1-27 Sec. 361.0851. FINANCIAL ASSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR USED  
 1-28 AND SCRAP TIRE HANDLERS. (a) In this section, "scrap tire" has the  
 1-29 meaning assigned by Section 361.112.  
 1-30 (b) This section does not apply to a registered used or  
 1-31 scrap tire processor using tires for energy recovery at an on-site  
 1-32 cement kiln or other energy recovery facility identified by  
 1-33 commission rule.  
 1-34 (c) The commission shall require a bond or other financial  
 1-35 assurance as a condition of issuing a registration for the  
 1-36 transportation, storage, or processing of scrap tires. The amount  
 1-37 of the bond or other financial assurance required must be  
 1-38 sufficient to cover the reasonable expenses of an immediate  
 1-39 remedial or removal action under Section 361.1125.  
 1-40 SECTION 2. Section 361.112, Health and Safety Code, is  
 1-41 amended by adding Subsections (o) and (p) to read as follows:  
 1-42 (o) The commission shall require a used or scrap tire  
 1-43 transporter to submit to the commission an annual report on the  
 1-44 records maintained by the transporter under this section. A used or  
 1-45 scrap tire transporter who fails to submit an annual report under  
 1-46 this subsection is not eligible to receive a registration insignia  
 1-47 under Subsection (p).  
 1-48 (p) The commission shall annually issue a registration  
 1-49 insignia to each used or scrap tire transporter. The used or scrap  
 1-50 tire transporter shall display the insignia on each vehicle used to  
 1-51 transport tires under the registration. The insignia expires  
 1-52 annually on a date specified by the commission. The commission may  
 1-53 adopt rules for issuing duplicate and multiple insignia.  
 1-54 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
