1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to authorizing certain cities to change the date on which
1-21 their general election for officers is held.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
1-24 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

1-25 (f) The governing body of a city with a population of 1.18
1-26 million or more, located predominantly in a county that has a total
1-27 area of less than 1,000 square miles, that has adopted a
1-28 council-manager form of government and that holds its general
1-29 election for officers on a date other than the November uniform
1-30 election date may, not later than December 31, 2020, change the date
1-31 on which it holds its general election for officers to the November
1-32 uniform election date. This subsection expires January 1, 2021.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
