1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the requirement that a motor vehicle dealer obtain a  
1-20 general distinguishing number for a consignment location.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 503.027(a), Transportation Code, is  
1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) A [~~If a dealer consigns for sale more than five vehicles~~  
1-25 ~~in a calendar year from a location other than the location for which~~  
1-26 ~~the dealer holds a general distinguishing number, the~~] dealer must  
1-27 [~~also~~] hold a general distinguishing number for a [~~the~~] consignment  
1-28 location unless the consignment location is a wholesale motor  
1-29 vehicle auction.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
