 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the contents of a notice of appraised value sent to a
 1-18 property owner by the chief appraiser of an appraisal district.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 25.19, Tax Code, is amended by adding
 1-21 Subsection (1) to read as follows:

1-22 (1) In addition to the information required by Subsection
 1-23 (b), the chief appraiser shall include with a notice required by
 1-24 Subsection (a) a brief explanation of each total or partial
 1-25 exemption of property from taxation required or authorized by this
 1-26 title that is available to:

1-27 (1) a disabled veteran or the veteran's surviving
 1-28 spouse or child;

1-29 (2) an individual who is 65 years of age or older or
 1-30 the individual's surviving spouse;

1-31 (3) an individual who is disabled or the individual's
 1-32 surviving spouse;

1-33 (4) the surviving spouse of a member of the armed
 1-34 services of the United States who is killed in action; or

1-35 (5) the surviving spouse of a first responder who is
 1-36 killed or fatally injured in the line of duty.

1-37 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-38 to a notice of appraised value for a tax year beginning on or after
 1-39 the effective date of this Act. A notice of appraised value for a
 1-40 tax year beginning before the effective date of this Act is governed
 1-41 by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this
 1-42 Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2020.
