1-17 relating to the maintenance and operation of certain projects by
 1-18 certain drainage districts.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Chapter 34, Acts of the 57th Legislature, 3rd
 1-21 Called Session, 1962, is amended by adding Section 19 to read as
 1-22 follows:

1-23 Sec. 19. (a) The District may enter into a project
 1-24 partnership agreement with the United States Army Corps of
 1-25 Engineers for a project proposed to be located in the District and
 1-26 listed in the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Texas Coastal Storm Risk
 1-27 Management and Ecosystem Restoration report published by the United
 1-28 States Army Corps of Engineers in May 2017. If the District enters
 1-29 into a project partnership agreement under this subsection, the
 1-30 District:

1-31 (1) must:

1-32 (A) develop a maintenance and operation plan for
 1-33 the proposed project; and

1-34 (B) biennially submit a report to the General
 1-35 Land Office and the legislature on expenditures of state money
 1-36 relating to a project described by this subsection; and

1-37 (2) may enter into an agreement for a public-private
 1-38 partnership to fund a local share of or the costs of the operation
 1-39 and maintenance of a project described by this subsection.

1-40 (a-1) If the District enters into a project partnership
 1-41 agreement under this section before November 1, 2020, the initial
 1-42 report described by Subsection (a)(1)(B) must be submitted not
 1-43 later than December 1, 2020. This subsection expires January 1,
 1-44 2021.

1-45 (b) If a project described by Subsection (a) is built in the
 1-46 District, the District may accept money from any source to:

2-31 States Army Corps of Engineers in May 2017. If the District enters
2-32 into a project partnership agreement under this subsection, the
