1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the enforcement of traffic regulations on a public road  
1-18 that is owned, operated, and maintained by a special district.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 791.036, Government Code, is amended to  
1-21 read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 791.036. REGULATION OF TRAFFIC IN SPECIAL DISTRICTS.  
1-23 The commissioners court of a county may enter into an interlocal  
1-24 contract with the board of a special district for the county to:

1-25 (1) apply the county's traffic regulations to a public  
1-26 road in the county that is owned, operated, and maintained by the  
1-27 district if the commissioners court finds that it is in the county's  
1-28 interest to regulate traffic on the public road; and

1-29 (2) enforce the regulations.

1-30 SECTION 2. Section 251.151(b), Transportation Code, is  
1-31 amended to read as follows:

1-32 (b) Under the terms of an interlocal contract under Section  
1-33 791.036, Government Code, the [The] commissioners court of a county  
1-34 may:

1-35 (1) by order apply the county's traffic regulations to  
1-36 a public road in the county that is owned, operated, and maintained  
1-37 by a special district and located wholly or partly in the county;  
1-38 and

1-39 (2) provide for the enforcement of the regulations [if  
1-40 the commissioners court and the board of the district have entered  
1-41 into an interlocal contract under Section 791.036, Government  
1-42 Code].

1-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-44 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-45 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-46 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-47 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
