 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Section 46.03(a-1), Penal Code, is amended to
 1-20 read as follows:
 1-21 (a-1) A person commits an offense if the person
 1-22 intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly possesses or goes with a
 1-23 location-restricted knife:
 1-24 (1) ~~[on the premises of a business that has a permit or~~
 1-25 ~~license issued under Chapter 25, 28, 32, 69, or 74, Alcoholic~~
 1-26 ~~Beverage Code, if the business derives 51 percent or more of its~~
 1-27 ~~income from the sale or service of alcoholic beverages for~~
 1-28 ~~on-premises consumption, as determined by the Texas Alcoholic~~
 1-29 ~~Beverage Commission under Section 104.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code;~~
 1-30 ~~[(2)]~~ on the premises where a high school, collegiate,
 1-31 or professional sporting event or interscholastic event is taking

 1-47 SECTION 2. Section 46.03(c)(2), Penal Code, is amended to

 1-49 (2) "Premises" has ~~["Amusement park" and "premises"~~
 1-50 ~~have]~~ the meaning ~~[meanings]~~ assigned by Section 46.035.
 1-51 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-52 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
 1-53 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
 1-54 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
 1-55 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
 1-56 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
 1-57 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
 1-58 before that date.
 1-59 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
