9	(1) "Employee" means an individual who is employed by

11	(2) "Employer" means a person who employs one or more
12	employees.
13	(3) "Employment benefit" means anything of value that
14	an employee receives from an employer in addition to monetary
15	compensation.
16	Sec. 83.002. PROHIBITED LOCAL REGULATIONS. (a) A
17	political subdivision of this state may not adopt or enforce any
18	ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy regulating a private
19	employer's terms of employment relating to employment benefits
20	other than employment leave, including health, disability,
21	retirement, profit-sharing, death, and group accidental death and
