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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle D, Title 2, Labor Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Chapter 83 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 83. LOCAL REGULATION OF EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES
- 8 Sec. 83.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 9 <u>(1) "Employee" means an individual who is employed by</u>
- 10 an employer for compensation.
- 11 (2) "Employer" means a person who employs one or more
- 12 employees.
- 13 Sec. 83.002. PROHIBITED LOCAL REGULATIONS. (a) A
- 14 political subdivision of this state may not adopt or enforce any
- 15 ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy regulating a private
- 16 employer's terms of employment relating to any form of employment
- 17 leave, including paid days off from work for holidays, sick leave,
- 18 vacation, and personal necessity.
- (b) An ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy that
- 20 violates this section is void and unenforceable.
- 21 SECTION 2. Chapter 83, Labor Code, as added by this Act,
- 22 applies to an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy adopted
- 23 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
