1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 2 proposing a constitutional amendment to increase the minimum amount

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 67(b)(3), Article XVI, Texas
- 7 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (3) The amount contributed by a person participating
- 9 in the Employees Retirement System of Texas or the Teacher
- 10 Retirement System of Texas shall be established by the legislature
- 11 but may not be less than six percent of current compensation. The
- 12 amount contributed by the state may not be less than $\underline{\text{seven}}$ [$\underline{\text{six}}$]
- 13 percent nor more than 10 percent of the aggregate compensation paid
- 14 to individuals participating in the system. In an emergency, as
- 15 determined by the governor, the legislature may appropriate such
- 16 additional sums as are actuarially determined to be required to
- 17 fund benefits authorized by law.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to improve the
- 22 actuarial soundness of the Employees Retirement System of Texas and
- 23 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas by authorizing an increase
- 24 in the minimum amount of the state's annual contribution to the

- 1 Employees Retirement System of Texas and the Teacher Retirement
- 2 System of Texas from six to seven percent of the total compensation
- 3 paid to individuals participating in the system."
