1-17 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-18 proposing a constitutional amendment to allow the transfer of a law
 1-19 enforcement animal to a qualified caretaker in certain
 1-20 circumstances.

1-21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
 1-23 adding Section 521 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 521. The legislature may authorize a state agency or a
 1-25 county, a municipality, or other political subdivision to transfer
 1-26 a law enforcement dog, horse, or other animal to the animal's
 1-27 handler or another qualified caretaker for no consideration on the
 1-28 animal's retirement or at another time if the transfer is in the
 1-29 animal's best interest.

1-30 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
 1-31 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
 1-32 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
 1-33 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to allow the transfer
 1-34 of a law enforcement animal to a qualified caretaker in certain
 1-35 circumstances."
