1-17 relating to the designation of April as Parkinson's Disease
 1-18 Awareness Month.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
 1-21 amended by adding Section 662.114 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 662.114. PARKINSON'S DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH. (a)
 1-23 April is Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month to increase awareness
 1-24 of Parkinson's disease and to encourage people to learn about the
 1-25 signs, symptoms, and treatment options for Parkinson's disease.

1-26 (b) Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month may be regularly
 1-27 observed through appropriate programs and activities to increase
 1-28 awareness of Parkinson's disease.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
