1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway Loop 121
 1-20 in Bell County as the Deputy Sheriff John Rhoden Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.190 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.190. DEPUTY SHERIFF JOHN RHODEN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

1-25 (a) The portion of State Highway Loop 121 in Bell County between
 1-26 its intersection with Interstate Highway 35 and its intersection
 1-27 with Interstate Highway 14 is designated as the Deputy Sheriff John
 1-28 Rhoden Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any
 1-29 other designation.

1-30 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-31 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-32 designation as the Deputy Sheriff John Rhoden Memorial Highway and
 1-33 any other appropriate information; and

1-34 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-35 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
