1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-21 AN ACT

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relating to the requirements for a junior college district to receive approval from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board 1-22 1-23 1-24 to offer baccalaureate degree programs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 130.307, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), a [A] public junior college may offer a baccalaureate degree program under this subchapter only if its junior college district:
- had a taxable property valuation amount of not (1)less than \$6 billion in the preceding year; and
- (2) received a positive assessment of the overall financial health of the district as reported by the coordinating board.
- The requirement of Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to a public junior college for the purpose of offering a baccalaureate degree program in nursing approved under Section 130.308 if its
- junior college district:

 (1) has a taxable property valuation amount of not less than \$4 billion in the preceding year; and
- (2) does not have a four-year institution of higher 1-44

education located in a county in which the district is located.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-45 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-46 1-47 1-48 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-49 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
