BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

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SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Section 1579.010 to read as follows: Sec. 1579.010. PARTICIPATING ENTITY REQUEST FOR CERTAIN INFORMATION.
