1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the general manager of the Upper Colorado River 1-20 Authority. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 8506.056(d), (e), and (f), Special District Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

(d) The board may employ a general manager. The general manager [presiding officer] is the chief executive officer of the

authority. The general manager may not be a member of the board.

(e) The secretary, secretary pro tem, presiding officer, general manager, and treasurer have the powers and duties, hold office for the term, and are subject to removal in the manner provided by the bylaws.

(f) The board shall set the compensation of the secretary, secretary pro tem, presiding officer, general manager, treasurer.

SECTION 2. Section 8506.058(c), Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

(c) The general manager  $[\frac{presiding\ officer}{}]$  is in charge of the authority's general office. 1-36 1-37 1-38

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
