1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue by
 1-21 certain municipalities.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 351, Tax Code, is amended
 1-24 by adding Section 351.1069 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 351.1069. ALLOCATION OF REVENUE: CERTAIN
 1-26 MUNICIPALITIES. In addition to other authorized uses, a
 1-27 municipality described by Section 351.1066(a)(6) may use revenue
 1-28 derived from the tax imposed under this chapter to promote tourism
 1-29 by enhancing and upgrading an existing sports facility or field,
 1-30 provided that the municipality complies with Section 351.1076.

1-31 SECTION 2. Section 351.1076(a), Tax Code, is amended to
 1-32 read as follows:

1-33 (a) A municipality that spends municipal hotel occupancy
 1-34 tax revenue for the enhancement and upgrading of existing sports
 1-35 facilities or fields as authorized by Section 351.101(a)(7) or (n),
 1-36 Section 351.1069, or Section 351.10711:

1-37 (1) shall determine the amount of municipal hotel
 1-38 occupancy tax revenue generated for the municipality by hotel
 1-39 activity attributable to the sports events and tournaments held on
 1-40 the enhanced or upgraded facilities or fields for five years after
 1-41 the date the enhancements and upgrades are completed; and

1-42 (2) may not spend hotel occupancy tax revenue for the
 1-43 enhancement and upgrading of the facilities or fields in a total
 1-44 amount that exceeds the amount of area hotel revenue attributable
 1-45 to the enhancements and upgrades.

1-46 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-47 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-48 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-49 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-50 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
