BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

(h) The <u>commission shall</u> [department may] automatically issue a <u>temporary</u> [provisional] license <u>to an existing facility</u> <u>licensed under this chapter that has</u> [in the case of] a [corporate] change of ownership [of a facility]. 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28

(i) The commission may issue a temporary license under 1-29 1-30 Subsection (h) without conducting an inspection of the facility if 1-31

<u>the commission determines an inspection is not necessary.</u> SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date of this Act, but not later than January 1, 2022, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall 1-32 1-33 1-34 1-35 adopt rules necessary to implement this Act. 1-36

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
