A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-17 1-18 AN ACT

> relating to the issuance of digital tags for the taking of certain animals.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 42, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended by adding Section 42.0101 to read as follows:

Sec. 42.0101. DIGITAL TAGS; RULES. The commission by (a) rule may develop and implement a program for the issuance of digital tags for animals, including birds, to holders of hunting licenses authorizing the taking of those animals.

(b) A program developed under this section may include:

(1) providing for the issuance of digital tags to the

holder of a hunting license;

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
