A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the penalties for a violation of a quarantine or rule to 1-20 protect pecans or pecan trees from diseases or pests; increasing 1-21 civil penalties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 71.012, Agriculture Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to 1-24 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (a-1) and (a-2), a [A] person who violates this subchapter or a rule adopted under this subchapter is liable to the state for a civil penalty of not less than \$250 nor more than \$10,000 for each violation. Each day a 1-27 1-28 1-29 1-30 violation continues may be considered a separate violation for 1-31 purposes of a civil penalty assessment.

(a-1) Subject to Subsection (a-2), a person who violates a quarantine established under this subchapter against a pest or 1-32 1-33 disease affecting pecans or pecan trees or violates a rule adopted 1-34 under this subchapter for the protection of pecans or pecan trees is 1-35 liable to the state for a civil penalty of not less than \$500 nor more than \$20,000 for each violation. Each day a violation continues may be considered a separate violation for purposes of a 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39 civil penalty assessment.

1-40 (a-2) For the first violation of a quarantine established under this subchapter against a pest or disease affecting pecans or pecan trees or a violation of a rule adopted under this subchapter for the protection of pecans or pecan trees, in lieu of a civil penalty, a registrant under Section 71.043 may remedy the violation 1-41 1-42 1-43 1 - 441-45 by entering into a compliance agreement with the department and 1-46 returning, treating, or destroying the article subject to the 1-47

<u>quarantine as directed by the department.</u> SECTION 2. Section 71.013, Agriculture Code, is amended by 1-48 1-49 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as 1-50 follows:

Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an [An] offense 1-51 (b) 1-52 under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.

1-53 (b-1) For the first violation constituting an offense under section, in lieu of a criminal penalty, a registrant under 1-54 this Section 71.043 may remedy the violation by entering into a compliance agreement with the department and returning, treating, 1-55 1-56 or destroying the article subject to the quarantine as directed by 1-57 1-58 the department. SECTION 3.

1-59 The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 1-60 an offense or other violation committed on or after September 1, 2021. An offense or other violation committed before September 1, 1-61

H.B. No. 3289 2-1 2021, is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense or 2-2 violation was committed, and the former law is continued in effect 2-3 for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense or 2-4 violation was committed before September 1, 2021, if any element of 2-5 the offense or violation occurred before that date. 2-6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
