 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the number of baccalaureate degree programs certain
 1-20 public junior colleges may offer.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 130.306(a), Education Code, is amended
 1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (a) A public junior college offering a baccalaureate degree
 1-25 program under this subchapter [~~Section 130.303(a)~~] may not offer
 1-26 more than five baccalaureate degree programs at any time.

1-27 SECTION 2. Section 130.306(b), Education Code, is repealed.

1-28 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
