1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to information regarding state agency vehicle fleets.  
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-21 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 2171.101, Government  
 1-22 Code, is amended to read as follows:  
 1-23 Sec. 2171.101. VEHICLE REPORTING SYSTEM; EXCEPTION.  
 1-24 SECTION 2. Section 2171.101, Government Code, is amended by  
 1-25 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as  
 1-26 follows:  
 1-27 (a) The office of vehicle fleet management shall establish a  
 1-28 vehicle reporting system to assist ~~each~~ state agencies ~~[agency]~~  
 1-29 in the management of agency ~~[its]~~ vehicle ~~fleets~~ ~~[fleet]~~. Except as  
 1-30 provided by Subsection (d), a ~~[A]~~ state agency shall ~~[be required~~  
 1-31 ~~to]~~ submit vehicle fleet ~~[the]~~ reports on a quarterly basis, not  
 1-32 earlier than the 45th day or later than the 60th day after the date  
 1-33 on which the quarter ends.  
 1-34 (d) A state agency with a fleet of more than 2,500 vehicles  
 1-35 shall establish and maintain a vehicle reporting system to assist  
 1-36 the agency in the management of the agency's vehicle fleet. Not  
 1-37 later than October 15 of each year, the agency shall submit to the  
 1-38 office of vehicle fleet management the information the office  
 1-39 requests regarding the agency's vehicle fleet for the previous  
 1-40 state fiscal year. The agency may provide the information in the  
 1-41 format used by the agency's reporting system. The agency is exempt  
 1-42 from paying to the office any fee for maintaining the vehicle  
 1-43 reporting system established under Subsection (a).  
 1-44 SECTION 3. Each state agency subject to Section  
 1-45 2171.101(d), Government Code, as added by this Act, shall:  
 1-46 (1) establish a vehicle reporting system for the  
 1-47 agency's vehicle fleet not later than October 1, 2021; and  
 1-48 (2) submit the report required by that subsection to  
 1-49 the office of vehicle fleet management not later than October 15,  
 1-50 2021, or a later date determined by the office.  
 1-51 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-52 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-53 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-54 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-55 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
