1-17 relating to designating December 1 as Rosa Parks Day.
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
 1-20 amended by adding Section 662.084 to read as follows:
 1-21 Sec. 662.084. ROSA PARKS DAY. (a) December 1 is Rosa Parks
 1-22 Day in honor of Rosa Louise McCauley Parks for her courageous act of
 1-23 refusing to give up her seat on a Montgomery, Alabama, bus to
 1-24 protest segregation which helped launch the civil rights movement
 1-25 in the United States.
 1-26 (b) Rosa Parks Day may be regularly observed by appropriate
 1-27 programs and activities.
 1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
