 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue by  
 1-21 certain municipalities.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 351.101, Tax Code, is amended by adding  
 1-24 Subsection (s) to read as follows:

1-25 (s) In addition to other authorized uses, a municipality  
 1-26 that has a population of 70,000 or more but less than 90,000 and is  
 1-27 located in two counties, one of which has a population of four  
 1-28 million or more and the other of which has a population of less than  
 1-29 50,000, may use revenue from the municipal hotel occupancy tax for  
 1-30 the promotion of tourism by the enhancement and upgrading of an  
 1-31 existing sports facility or field as specified by Subsection  
 1-32 (a)(7), provided that the requirements of Subsections (a)(7)(A) and  
 1-33 (C) and Section 351.1076 are met.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
