1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-20 AN ACT

relating to employing and training mental health professionals for the mental health program for veterans.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 434.352(a) and (b), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

- (a) The commission and the  $\frac{\text{Health and Human}}{\text{State Health}}$  Services  $\frac{\text{Commission}}{\text{State State}}$  shall coordinate to administer the mental health program for veterans developed under Chapter 1001, Health and Safety Code.
- (b) For the mental health program for veterans, commission shall:
- (1) provide training to peer service coordinators and peers in accordance with Section 434.353;
- (2) provide technical assistance to peer service coordinators and peers;
- (3) identify, train, and communicate licensed mental health community-based professionals, community-based organizations, and faith-based organizations;
- (4)coordinate services for justice involved veterans; [and]
- 1-41 (5) coordinate local delivery to immediate family members of veterans of mental health first aid for 1-42 veterans training; and 1-43
- (6) employ and train mental health professionals to 1-44 1-45 assist the Health and Human Services Commission in the administration of the program.

  SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 1-46
