1-19 relating to the dissemination of confidential information
 1-20 contained in the juvenile justice information system.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 58.106(a), Family Code, is amended to
 1-23 read as follows:

1-24 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section,
 1-25 information contained in the juvenile justice information system is
 1-26 confidential information for the use of the department and may not
 1-27 be disseminated by the department except:

1-28 (1) with the permission of the juvenile offender, to
 1-29 military personnel of this state or the United States;

1-30 (2) to a criminal justice agency as defined by Section
 1-31 411.082, Government Code;

1-32 (3) to a noncriminal justice agency authorized by
 1-33 federal statute or federal executive order to receive juvenile
 1-34 justice record information;

1-35 (4) to a juvenile justice agency;

1-36 (5) to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department;

1-37 (6) to the office of independent ombudsman of the
 1-38 Texas Juvenile Justice Department;

1-39 (7) to a district, county, justice, or municipal court
 1-40 exercising jurisdiction over a juvenile; and

1-41 (8) to the Department of Family and Protective
 1-42 Services or the Health and Human Services Commission as provided by
 1-43 Section 411.114, Government Code.

1-44 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-45 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-46 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-47 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-48 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
