1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the qualifications of directors of certain municipal
 1-20 development districts.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 377.051(e), Local Government Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (d), a person may qualify to
 1-25 serve as a director of a district if the person resides in the
 1-26 independent school district that serves the majority of the
 1-27 district and the district [that] is located in a municipality:

1-28 (1) with a population of more than 5,000 and less than
 1-29 6,000 and that is located wholly in a county with a population of
 1-30 more than 20,000 and less than 25,000 and that borders the Brazos
 1-31 River; or

1-32 (2) with a population of more than 1,488 and less than
 1-33 2,500 and that is located wholly in a county with a population of
 1-34 more than 20,000 and less than 30,000 that borders the Neches River
 1-35 and the Trinity River [~~if the person resides in the independent~~
 1-36 ~~school district that serves the majority of the district].~~

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-39 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
