## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the gualifications of directors of certain municipal 1-19 development districts. 1-20 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 377.051(e), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (d), a person may qualify to serve as a director of a district <u>if the person resides in the</u> <u>independent school district that serves the majority of the</u> <u>district and the district [that]</u> is located in a municipality: 1-25 1-26 1-27

1-28 (1) with a population of more than 5,000 and less than 6,000 and that is located wholly in a county with a population of 1-29 more than 20,000 and less than 25,000 and that borders the Brazos 1-30 1-31 River; or

(2) with a population of more than 1,488 and less than 2,500 and that is located wholly in a county with a population of 1-32 1-33 more than 20,000 and less than 30,000 that borders the Neches River 1-34 1-35 and the Trinity River [if the person resides in the independent school district that serves the majority of the district]. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-36

1-37 1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-40 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
