1-16 WHEREAS, The community of Celina is renowned for the special
 1-17 effort it makes to celebrate Halloween, and it has created a

 1-20 Texas; and

 1-27 course and other activities for younger children; and

1-28 WHEREAS, The Celina High School theater department
 1-29 contributes to the fun by presenting its special Halloween play,
 1-30 *Nightmare on the Hill*; the frightfully exciting evening concludes
 1-31 with the outdoor screening of a scary film in the square; and

1-32 WHEREAS, By joining together for Beware! Of the Square, the
 1-33 residents of Celina and surrounding communities have created a
 1-34 popular Halloween tradition that is beloved by young and old alike,
 1-35 and this delightful event serves as an opportunity to showcase the
 1-36 city and to enjoy a spooky good time; now, therefore, be it

1-37 RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas
 1-38 hereby designate Celina as the official Halloween Capital of North
 1-39 Texas; and, be it further

1-40 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section
 1-41 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect
 1-42 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally
 1-43 passed by the legislature.
