BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Article 42A.511(c), Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 1-21

(c) If a judge grants community supervision to a defendant convicted of an offense under Section 21.09, <u>42.091</u>, <u>42.092</u>, <u>42.10</u>, 1-22 1-23 1-24 or 42.105, Penal Code, the judge may:

1-25 (1) require the defendant to relinquish custody of any animals in the defendant's possession; 1-26

1-27 1-28 (2) prohibit the defendant from possessing or exercising control over any animals or residing in a household 1-29 where animals are present; or
