1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to reports on the prevalence of eating disorders and
 1-22 eating disorder-related deaths in this state.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. (a) The Department of State Health Services, in
 1-25 collaboration with the Health and Human Services Commission, shall
 1-26 prepare a report on the prevalence of eating disorders and eating
 1-27 disorder-related deaths in this state. The report must include:

1-28 (1) regional and statewide statistics regarding the
 1-29 prevalence of eating disorders and eating disorder-related deaths
 1-30 in this state;

1-31 (2) an overview of national trends in eating
 1-32 disorders; and

1-33 (3) an overview of state-funded behavioral health
 1-34 treatment options available to persons with eating disorders.

1-35 (b) The Department of State Health Services shall gather
 1-36 information for the report from:

1-37 (1) information collected by the department and the
 1-38 Health and Human Services Commission, including information from
 1-39 the department's vital statistics unit and the state Medicaid
 1-40 program; and

1-41 (2) hospitals, treatment centers, available surveys,
 1-42 and other relevant sources.

1-43 (c) Not later than December 1, 2023, the Department of State
 1-44 Health Services and the Health and Human Services Commission shall
 1-45 prepare and submit to the legislature a copy of the report and any
 1-46 recommendations for legislative or other action to reduce the
 1-47 prevalence of eating disorders and eating disorder-related deaths
 1-48 in this state. The department may post the report on the
 1-49 department's Internet website.

1-50 (d) The Department of State Health Services may accept
 1-51 gifts, grants, and donations from any source to fund expenses
 1-52 incurred by the department in preparing the report.

1-53 (e) This section expires September 1, 2024.

1-54 SECTION 2. (a) The Department of State Health Services
 1-55 shall prepare a report on the prevalence of eating disorders among
 1-56 youth in this state. When administering the Youth Risk Behavior
 1-57 Survey created by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to
 1-58 youth in this state, the department may include additional
 1-59 questions as necessary to assist the department in assessing the
 1-60 prevalence of eating disorders among the youth for purposes of the

2-1 report.

2-2 (b) Not later than December 1, 2024, the Department of State
2-3 Health Services shall submit to the legislature a copy of the report
2-4 and a summary of the survey findings relating to the prevalence of
2-5 eating disorders among youth in this state. The department may post
2-6 the report and summary on the department's Internet website.

2-7 (c) The Department of State Health Services may accept
2-8 gifts, grants, and donations from any source to fund expenses
2-9 incurred by the department in preparing the report.

2-10 (d) This section expires September 1, 2025.

2-11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-15 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
