1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to parental access to public school virtual instruction
 1-23 and instructional materials for virtual and remote learning.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 26.006(a), Education Code, is amended to
 1-26 read as follows:

1-27 (a) A parent is entitled to:

1-28 (1) review all teaching materials, instructional
 1-29 materials, and other teaching aids used in the classroom of the
 1-30 parent's child, including while the child is participating in
 1-31 virtual or remote learning; ~~and~~

1-32 (2) review each test administered to the parent's
 1-33 child after the test is administered; and

1-34 (3) observe virtual instruction while the parent's
 1-35 child is participating in virtual or remote learning to the same
 1-36 extent the parent would be entitled to observe in-person
 1-37 instruction of the child.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
