1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the sale of wine and beer on Sundays.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 24.07, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:
 1-23 Sec. 24.07. WHEN LICENSE ALSO HELD: HOURS OF SALE, ETC. A
 1-24 holder of a wine only package store permit who also holds a retail
 1-25 dealer's off-premise license for the same location may remain open
 1-26 and sell ale, wine, vinous liquors, and beer, for off-premises
 1-27 consumption only, on any day and during the same hours as those
 1-28 prescribed for the sale of beer under Section 105.05 [~~that the~~
 1-29 ~~holder of a wine and beer retailer's permit may sell ale, beer, and~~
 1-30 ~~wine~~], except that the permit holder [~~he~~] may not sell wine or
 1-31 vinous liquor containing more than 17 percent alcohol by volume on a
 1-32 Sunday or after 10 p.m. on any day.
 1-33 SECTION 2. Section 105.04, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-34 amended to read as follows:
 1-35 Sec. 105.04. HOURS OF SALE: WINE AND BEER RETAILER. The
 1-36 hours of sale and delivery for alcoholic beverages sold under a wine
 1-37 and beer retailer's permit or a wine and beer retailer's off-premise
 1-38 permit are the same as those prescribed for the sale of beer under
 1-39 Section 105.05 [~~of this code, except that no sale shall be allowed~~
 1-40 ~~between 2 a.m. and noon on Sunday~~].
 1-41 SECTION 3. Section 105.05(b), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-42 amended to read as follows:
 1-43 (b) A person may sell, offer for sale, or deliver beer
 1-44 between 7 a.m. and midnight on any day except Sunday. On Sunday a
 1-45 person [~~he~~] may sell beer between midnight and 1:00 a.m. and between
 1-46 noon and midnight, except that:
 1-47 (1) permittees or licensees authorized to sell for
 1-48 on-premise consumption may sell beer between 10:00 a.m. and noon if
 1-49 the beer is served to a customer during the service of food to the
 1-50 customer; and
 1-51 (2) holders of a retail dealer's on-premise license or
 1-52 a retail dealer's off-premise license may also sell beer for
 1-53 off-premise consumption between 10:00 a.m. and noon.
 1-54 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
