1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to Medicaid coverage of certain collaborative care
 1-22 management services.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 32.024, Human Resources Code, is amended
 1-25 by adding Subsection (oo) to read as follows:

1-26 (oo) The commission shall provide medical assistance
 1-27 reimbursement to a treating health care provider who participates
 1-28 in Medicaid for the provision to a child or adult medical assistance
 1-29 recipient of behavioral health services that are classified by a
 1-30 Current Procedural Terminology code as collaborative care
 1-31 management services.

1-32 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
 1-33 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
 1-34 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
 1-35 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
 1-36 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
 1-37 waiver or authorization is granted.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
