## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the expiration of a school marshal license issued or 1-21 1-22 renewed by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement. 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1701.260(g), Occupations Code, 1-24 is 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (g) A person's license under this section expires on August 31 following [the first birthday of the person occurring after] the second anniversary of the date the commission licenses the person. 1-27 1-28 1-29 A renewed school marshal license expires on August 31 [the person's 1-30 birth date], two years after the expiration of the previous 1-31 license.

SECTION 2. Section 1701.260(g), Occupations 1-32 Code, as 1-33 amended by this Act, applies to a license issued or renewed under 1-34 that section regardless of whether the license was issued or renewed before, on, or after the effective date of this Act. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 1-35 1-36
