1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to verification of the citizenship status of certain
 1-22 registered voters.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 16.0332, Election Code, is amended by
 1-25 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
 1-26 follows:

1-27 (a) After the registrar receives notification [~~a list~~]
 1-28 under Section 18.068 of this code or Section 62.113, Government
 1-29 Code, of persons excused or disqualified from jury service because
 1-30 of citizenship status or notification of persons who have indicated
 1-31 a lack of citizenship status in connection with a motor vehicle or
 1-32 Department of Public Safety record, the registrar shall deliver to
 1-33 each registered voter whose name appears on the list a written
 1-34 notice requiring the voter to submit to the registrar proof of
 1-35 United States citizenship in the form of a certified copy of the
 1-36 voter's birth certificate, United States passport, or certificate
 1-37 of naturalization or any other form prescribed by the secretary of
 1-38 state. The notice shall be delivered by forwardable mail to the
 1-39 mailing address on the voter's registration application and to any
 1-40 new address of the voter known to the registrar.

1-41 (d) The secretary of state shall prescribe rules for the
 1-42 administration of this section.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-44 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-45 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-46 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-47 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
