An applicant for a massage therapist license may satisfy the requirements of Sections 455.156(b)(1)(B)-(H), Occupations Code, using distance learning as provided by Section 455.156(c), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, regardless of whether the application is submitted before, on, or after the 2-8 2-9 2**-**10 2**-**11 effective date of this Act. 2-12

SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2-13 2021, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules necessary 2-14 2**-**15 2**-**16 to implement the changes in law made by this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 2-17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 2-18 2-19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 2-20 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
