1-19 relating to the eligibility of the National Hot Rod Association  
 1-20 Fall Nationals at the Texas Motorplex for funding under the Major

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Sections 478.0001(3) and (7), Government Code,  
 1-24 as effective April 1, 2021, are amended to read as follows:
