A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the adjustment of the average daily attendance of a school district on the basis of a calamity. 1-21 1-22 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 48.005(d), Education Code, is amended to 1-25 read as follows:

(d) The commissioner may adjust the average daily attendance of a school district in which a disaster, flood, extreme 1-26 1-27 1-28 weather condition, fuel curtailment, or other calamity has a significant effect on the district's attendance. In addition to 1-29 providing the adjustment for the amount of instructional days during the semester in which the calamity first occurred, an adjustment under this section may only be provided based on a particular calamity for an additional amount of instructional days 1-30 1-31 1-32 1-33 1-34 equivalent to one school year. The commissioner may divide the 1-35 adjustment between two consecutive school years. 1-36

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
