1-21 relating to licensing and examination requirements for persons
 1-22 engaged in liquefied petroleum gas activities.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 113.095, Natural
 1-25 Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 113.095. LICENSE AND EXAMINATION BY ENDORSEMENT:
 1-27 OUT-OF-STATE LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION.

1-28 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 113, Natural Resources
 1-29 Code, is amended by adding Section 113.0955 to read as follows:

1-30 Sec. 113.0955. LICENSE AND EXAMINATION BY ENDORSEMENT:
 1-31 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED TRAINING. The commission by rule shall waive
 1-32 the requirements of Section 113.087 for an applicant for a license
 1-33 for cylinder filling who:

1-34 (1) has completed training consistent with the
 1-35 guidelines established by the Propane Education & Research Council;

1-36 (2) submits proof of completion of training described
 1-37 by Subdivision (1);

1-38 (3) submits an application for that type of license;
 1-39 and

1-40 (4) pays the applicable original nonrefundable
 1-41 license fee as established by the commission under Section 113.082.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
